## Permit for the transportation of hazardous waste and all kinds of other waste

### Permit

The County Administrative Board of Västerbotten grants AS Lajos identification number 10132895, a permit for the transportation of waste in accordance with Chapter 5 Section 1 of the Waste Ordinance (2020:614) in the scope and under the conditions specified below.

The permit covers container and bulk transport of all types of hazardous waste not classified as dangerous goods under the regulations concerning the transport of dangerous goods; the permit is valid until **the 20 April 2026**.

The permit also includes general container and bulk transport of waste that is not hazardous waste; the permit is valid until **further notice**.

The County Administrative Board of Västerbotten revoke the permission dated 3 February 2016 (562-750-2016).

AS Lajos is based in Kunda, Estonia.

### Conditions

1. Unless otherwise specified in other conditions, the business shall be conducted in conformance with the provisions set forth in the application documents.
2. A copy of this permit shall accompany each vehicle transporting waste under this permit.
3. The permit holder must keep themselves informed and ensure that the staffs who handle waste have the requisite knowledge concerning the risks, precautionary measures and rules that apply to the transportation.
4. During transport, vehicles shall carry suitable equipment with them for collecting spills and disposing of any leaking containers.
5. In case of an accident, you must take the necessary steps to limit injury or inconvenience to human health or the environment.
6. The carrier should have sufficient knowledge of the waste's content to select an appropriate waste receiver in each individual case.

7. The company shall have all their vehicles that are to be used for transportation of waste covered by third party insurance. The company shall also have liability insurance covering the liability which may be imposed on the company in the case of damage that does not fall under the Swedish Traffic Damage Act's regulations and therefore is not compensated from the third party insurance.

#### **Conditions for the transportation of hazardous waste**

8. Different types of waste shall be kept separate from each other during transport.
9. Drums, containers and other receptacles should be tightly closed during transport. They shall be cleaned before being used for the transportation of other types of waste. Any cleaning solution shall be disposed of in the same manner as the waste most recently transported in the receptacle.
10. Cleaning of vehicles and containers shall take place in an appropriate designated place so that the residual waste and contaminated cleaning solutions can be collected.
11. In order to transport moveable containers, drums or the like, they must be whole and clearly labelled with what the package contains.
12. Types of waste which may react dangerously with each other, especially acidic baths, alkaline concentrated baths and cyanide-concentrated waste or flammable waste and strong oxidizing waste, may only be transported if the mixed packing, mixed loading and separation regulations in ADR are complied with. When concentrated acidic waste is transported, corrosion and acid-resistant equipment must be used.
13. When contaminated soil and similar substances are transported, precautionary measures must be taken so that the material does not create dust clouds.
14. During transport, vehicles shall carry suitable equipment with them for collecting spills and disposing of any leaking containers.
15. Drivers of this type of transport must be well informed about what action is to be taken in the event of a leak, spill, and accident or similar. The Environmental and Public Health Office and emergency services shall be immediately informed in the event of a leak or accident.
16. The Swedish Civil Contingencies Agency's requirements must be followed regarding ADR training when transporting hazardous waste classified as dangerous goods.

#### **Special terms and conditions**

17. With regard to transports that require ADR-approved vehicles, the permit only covers media specified in the vehicle's certificate. The permit's validity is predicated on the vehicle's certificate being kept up to date.

## **Justification for the decision**

According to section Chapter 5, Section 3 of the Waste Ordinance (2020:614), waste and hazardous waste may only be issued to those who show that they have personnel, technical and economic conditions to handle the waste in a way that meets the requirements for the protection of health and environment.

The County Administrative Board of Västerbotten assesses that the applicant complies with the requirements of Chapter 5, Section 3 of the Waste Ordinance (2020:614). Authorization for transport of waste or hazardous waste can therefore be given.

## **Information**

According to Chapter 24, Section 3 of the Environmental Code, this permit may be completely or partly revoked if the reasons stated in the Code apply. See information in Appendix 3.

When hazardous waste is transported within Sweden, the waste must be accompanied by a transport document. The transport must also be recorded in accordance with provisions on the obligation to make notes. See information in Appendix 2, as well as additional provisions in the Waste Ordinance.

In case of an accident, the municipality's environmental and health protection office and / or emergency service should be immediately informed.

The license holder shall keep informed of the laws and regulations that apply to the operation and hold the permits required for transport activities under other legislation, see Appendix 2 for examples of relevant legislation.

What is hazardous waste can be found in Chapter 2 Section 3 of the Waste Ordinance (2020:614). The paragraphs further refer to Annex to Directive 2008/98 / EC. Annex 3 lists hazardous waste properties. If waste contains substances that include Explosive, oxidizing, flammable, irritating, harmful, toxic, cancers, corrosive, infectious, toxic to reproduction, mutagenic, allergenic or ecotoxic are classified as hazardous waste.
